Who will be invited to participate?

If you are an adult and have an appointment with a Primary Care Practitioner who is already taking part in the TIP study you may be sent an invitation to take part.

Before your appointment

During your appointment

Your consultation at your GP surgery will happen as normal.

Please do not discuss this study with your Primary Care Practitioner.

It is important that your Primary Care Practitioner does not know whether you are taking part.



After your appointment

You will be sent a link to fill in some questionnaires after 1 week, 1 month, 3 months and 6 months. These questionnaires ask about your appointment, your health, and quality of life. They take about 15 minutes to do.
